


Registration and Concerns History

The College posts the registration history of all pharmacy professionals to help you understand a little more about their experience and background – important information to help you make an informed decision.

The College also manages the complaints resolution process related to pharmacies and pharmacy professionals in Ontario. Using the public register, you can view whether the College has posted publicly available information related to a concern or a disciplinary matter that has come before the College related to a pharmacy professional or pharmacy.





MAKE AN INFORMED DECISION ABOUT Your Pharmacy Care

The Ontario College of Pharmacists is the registering and regulating body for the profession of pharmacy in Ontario with a mandate to serve and protect the public.

The "Find a Pharmacy or Pharmacy Professional" tool on the College website, also known as a public register, can be valuable for you as a patient. It helps you learn more about your pharmacy and pharmacy professionals so you can make an informed choice about your care.







Pharmacy Assessment Outcomes

Pharmacies in Ontario get assessed regularly by the College. Helping to make sure pharmacies are operating safely and the public is receiving safe and effective care is one of the primary ways the College ensures that you, as a pharmacy patient, are protected. Only pharmacies that have been assessed and have met specified quality and safety criteria are authorized to operate in the province.

For every pharmacy assessment, the College posts the date, the reason for the assessment, and the outcome of the assessment.





Pharmacists With Registered Injection Training

Using the public register, you're able to find pharmacists near you with registered training in injections (those authorized to give the flu shot or selected travel vaccines to you and your family members).

Language Search

With the public register, you can find a pharmacy professional near you who speaks a particular language or dialect.
