Specified Offences Triggering Mandatory Revocation

Additional changes to regulations under the *Regulated Health Professions Act* that are now in effect have specified the sexual offences under the *Criminal Code* which will trigger mandatory revocation of a regulated health professional's certificate of registration. The mandatory revocation provision will apply to persons found guilty of the following offences:

- 151 - Sexual interference
- 152 - Invitation to sexual touching
- 153 - Sexual exploitation
- 153.1 - Sexual exploitation of a person with disability
- 160 (3) - Bestiality in the presence of or by a child
- 162 - Voyeurism
- 162.1 - Publication, etc., of an intimate image without consent
- 163.1 - Child pornography
- 170 - Parent or guardian procuring sexual activity
- 171.1 - Making sexually explicit material available to a child
- 172.1 - Luring a child
- 172.2 - Agreement or arrangement - sexual offence against a child
- 271 - Sexual assault
- 272 - Sexual assault with a weapon, threats to a third party or causing bodily harm, and
- 273 - Aggravated sexual assault.
